PICK UP SERVICE FROM THE AIRPORT

Would you arrive by plane, we pick you up at the airport and take you back there on Sunday for EUR 50/person. In this case please inform us about the exact time of arrival and the number of the flight in advance.

TOURNAMENT TRANSPORT

Tournament transport is available only for players who have already paid for package! There will be a bus transfer service available between the hotel and the club. The first bus starts from the hotel to the club at 9.00 and the last from the club to the hotel after party (cc. 23:30h) every day, during the competition. The buses run between the hotels and the club only. You can find the bus schedule in the club and the hotel too. **We also have a minibus (for 8 persons) running all day. If needed please ask the manager in the tournament office.**

TOURNAMENT NORMS, REGULATIONS

- 1- Each player will play a minimum of 3 matches.
- 2- The competition will be organized in O35, O45 women, and O35, O40, O45, O50, O55, O60 men categories.
- 3- Matches will be organized on tables of 16 or 32 on the grounds of **KO system, but every place will be played out.** The organizers may form groups in case of few competitors.
- 4- All matches will be played according to the WSF rules; best of 5 games. Organizing committee reserves the right to play the best of 3 games in plates, if needed.
- 5- Player, who is more than 5 minutes late from her/his own match, will loose her/his match.
- 6- All players must be ready to referee the matches the Tournament Referee designates. Referee must report to the tournament office; collect the player cards, score sheet and the ball; then return those to the tournament office at the end of the match. Before the match they have to take the whole referee package - strip, pen, report, mock sheet, 1 ball, players card, result card - over, and hand all the above mentioned back after the match.
- 7- Any suggestions or complaints should be made to the Tournament Director.
- 8- All hotel costs, such as mini-bar, telephone, TV must be paid at checking out. Any breakage must be paid immediately!
- 9- All players must attend all their matches, also the closing ceremony, which will be held as soon as the final results of each categories are known.
